Dear Parents, Welcome back, we hope you had a lovely Easter break. Our main topic for the period 19 April 2022 to 20 July 2022 is

ON THE FARM

- During this term we will be planting seeds and watching our plants grow, whilst understanding what they need to thrive. We will be looking at the story Who's on the Farm by Julia Donaldson.
- We will also be looking at the life cycles of a Hen and of an Apple Tree.
- We shall be exploring with paint and textures.

You may wish to talk about these topics with your child. Our suggested activities are:

- discussing life cycles and how things grow.
- looking at repeating patterns and practicing numbers.
- encouraging your child to get dressed by themselves and put on their shoes.

Covid Precautions
